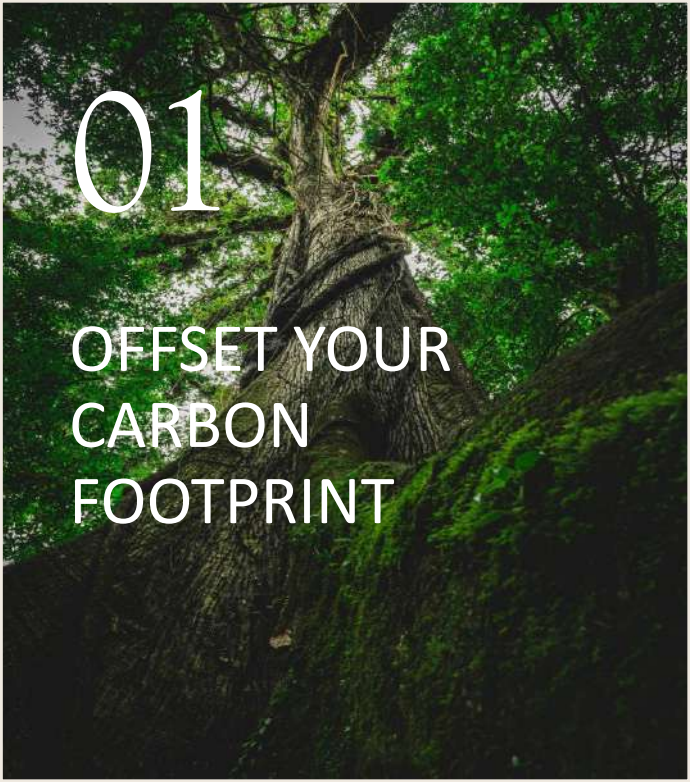

OFFSET YOUR CARBON FOOTPRINT

WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

Every trip generates carbon emissions, whether through flights, transportation, or activities. With FONAFIFO (Costa Rica's National Forest Financing Fund), you can offset that footprint by supporting forest conservation and reforestation efforts in the country.

YOUR IMPACT

By offsetting your footprint, you help fund the protection of natural areas and contribute to capturing CO₂ from the atmosphere, directly supporting the fight against climate change.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

We calculate the carbon footprint of your trip and manage the purchase of offset credits on your behalf. You will receive an official certificate recognizing your contribution to the conservation of Costa Rican forests.



WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

Many animals in Costa Rica are rescued due to accidents, illegal trafficking, or habitat loss. The Jaguar Rescue Center rehabilitates species such as sloths, monkeys, and wild cats with the goal of returning them to nature. By adopting an animal, you contribute directly to its care and recovery.

YOUR IMPACT

Your support funds the feeding, veterinary care, and reintroduction of animals into their natural habitat, helping to preserve Costa Rica's wildlife.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

You can choose the animal you wish to sponsor and select from three donation amounts. You will receive an adoption certificate and regular updates on its condition and progress.

VETERINARY HOSPITAL

USD \$80

Caring for and rehabilitating injured animals requires many resources. Your support helps provide them with shelter, medical attention, and preparation for their return to the wild.



SYMBOLIC ADOPTION

You can symbolically adopt an animal for one year to cover its weekly expenses. This supports its rescue, rehabilitation, and feeding.

The Shock Free Zone project works to prevent the electrocution of wildlife by insulating power lines, installing wildlife crossings, and promoting sustainable urban development in Costa Rica's Southern Caribbean region.

HELP PROTECT THE OCEAN'S GUARDIAN

WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

The hammerhead shark is a key species for maintaining the balance of marine ecosystems, but it faces serious threats such as overfishing and the loss of critical habitats. Misión Tiburón works toward its conservation through scientific research, protection of nursery areas like the Golfo Dulce, and education of local communities about the importance of these guardians of the ocean.

YOUR IMPACT

Your donation supports research, monitoring, and environmental education programs aimed at conserving hammerhead sharks and other endangered marine species. This includes satellite tagging, studying migratory routes, and protecting critical habitats such as mangroves and coastal areas where juveniles are born.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

Participate by choosing a donation amount to support these programs. By sponsoring a shark, you will receive a digital certificate with the name of a monitored individual and information about its species, along with updates on the action.

ADOPT AN OCEAN GUARDIAN

The coastal youth of Golfo Dulce are the main guardians of the shark sanctuary. We have developed a kit that empowers young community leaders committed to spreading the message of conservation.



FIGHT CLIMATE CHANGE
